

TOLSONS DEMANDS RE- ASSESSMENT OF FLOOD RISK

Local Liberal Democrat MSP Jim Tolson has demanded that the Scottish Executive take the necessary action to protect homes across Dunfermline West from possible flooding.

Speaking after lodging questions in parliament on the matter Mr Tolson said

“We have to look ahead and protect homes. Risk of flooding should be one of the major considerations when the local authority is passing any new house building plans.

We have seen in other areas of the country, the effect of the flooding has been devastating and the aftermath will be felt for many months if not years. As the weather is changing in Scotland, the flood risk may be increasing in certain areas. The Scottish Executive has a responsibility to my constituents to reassess any possible risks. “
