Tolson welcomes better service for ferry foot passengers

After campaigning for foot passenger services with new ferry operator, Norfolkline, Jim Tolson MSP for Dunfermline has welcomed the news that a new bus service will be in place for foot passengers for the start of the new Rosyth ferry service on 19 May 2009.

Jim commented "Fife Council and SEStran will be delivering a free shuttle bus service for foot passengers between the Ferry Terminal, Ferrytoll Park & Ride and Inverkeithing Railway Station. This is excellent news for foot passengers on this service giving them an excellent link into the public transport service in the area. "

Notes to Editor

1. It is proposed that the service will operate from 1300 – 1600 at every 20 minute intervals. The ferry arrives at 1300 with passengers disembarking by 1320/1330 and check-in closing at 1600. The shuttle bus will be wheelchair accessible.
2. Fife Council and SEStran will be funding the service for one year and will then review the service. Edinburgh Council and Norfolkline have declined to be partners in the service.
